



## Shorter College Courtside and President's Box Seating Agreement Henry A. Belin Jr. Health Plex

As a Shorter College Floor or President's Box Seat holder for basketball games in the Henry A. Belin Jr. Health Plex, I understand and agree that the high visibility of my seat(s) requires compliance with the guidelines established by Shorter College and the Department of Intercollegiate Athletics.

### 1. Spectator Conduct

I understand and agree to comply with the spectator conduct requirements of Shorter College, which include the following:

*"In the interest of fostering an enjoyable and positive atmosphere for all spectators, Shorter College Athletics expects the bearer of floor and/or President's Box Seat tickets to behave in a responsible and considerate manner. Vulgar or abusive language, physical actions that threaten the safety of competitors or spectators, intoxication or drug use, and disorderly conduct will not be tolerated. Individuals displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the Henry A. Belin Jr. Health Plex, and their tickets will be forfeited. Shorter College reserves the right to revoke and/or refuse the sale of tickets, including to any individual, season ticket holder, President's Box Seat holder, or Floor Seat holder, who violates or refuses to comply with this code of conduct."*

### 2. Movement in the Floor Seating Area

In consideration of other spectators and to ensure the safety of student-athletes, walking in the floor seat area should be limited to pre-game, timeouts, halftime, and post-game.

### 3. Prohibited Conduct

I understand and agree that individuals seated in floor seats must not physically threaten or approach any referee, athlete, fellow spectator, or otherwise interfere with the competition. Such actions may result in a technical foul being assessed against Shorter College.

### 4. Authority of Game Officials and Administrators

I understand and agree that game officials, Shorter College administrators, game day personnel, or referees (within conference, College, and NJCAA rules) reserve the right to ask game management to remove any spectator who they deem to be acting in a manner that threatens the safety of participants, staff, or other spectators.

### 5. Technical Fouls and Disciplinary Action

If an individual seated in floor seats is assessed a technical foul, disciplinary action will be taken against both the individual and the floor seat holder. Such action may include removal from the current contest and/or future contests.

### 6. Seat Utilization

Floor seat holders enjoy some of the best seats in the house and play an important role in creating a strong home-court advantage for our Men's and Women's Basketball teams.
